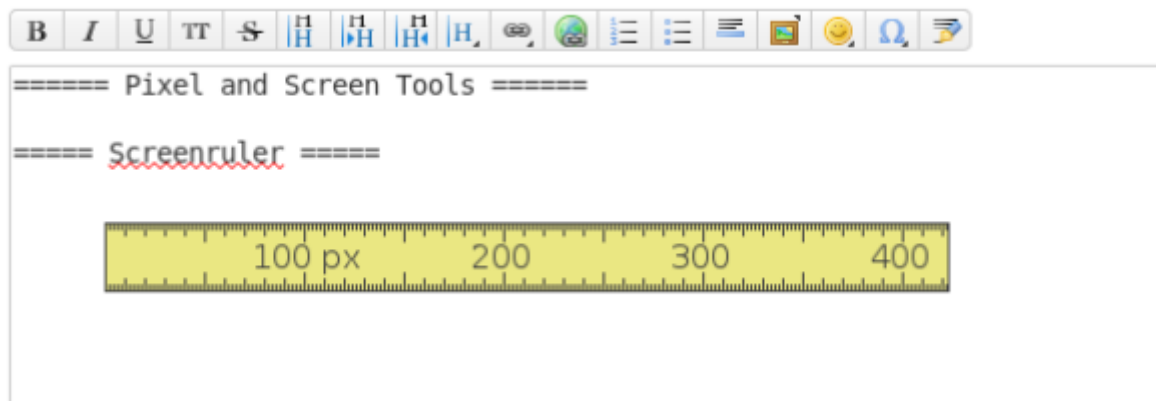


# Pixel and Screen Tools

## Screenruler

```
sudo apt install screenruler
```



Helps to measure pixels on a display. If you set your physical resolution correctly, you can also measure in millimeters.

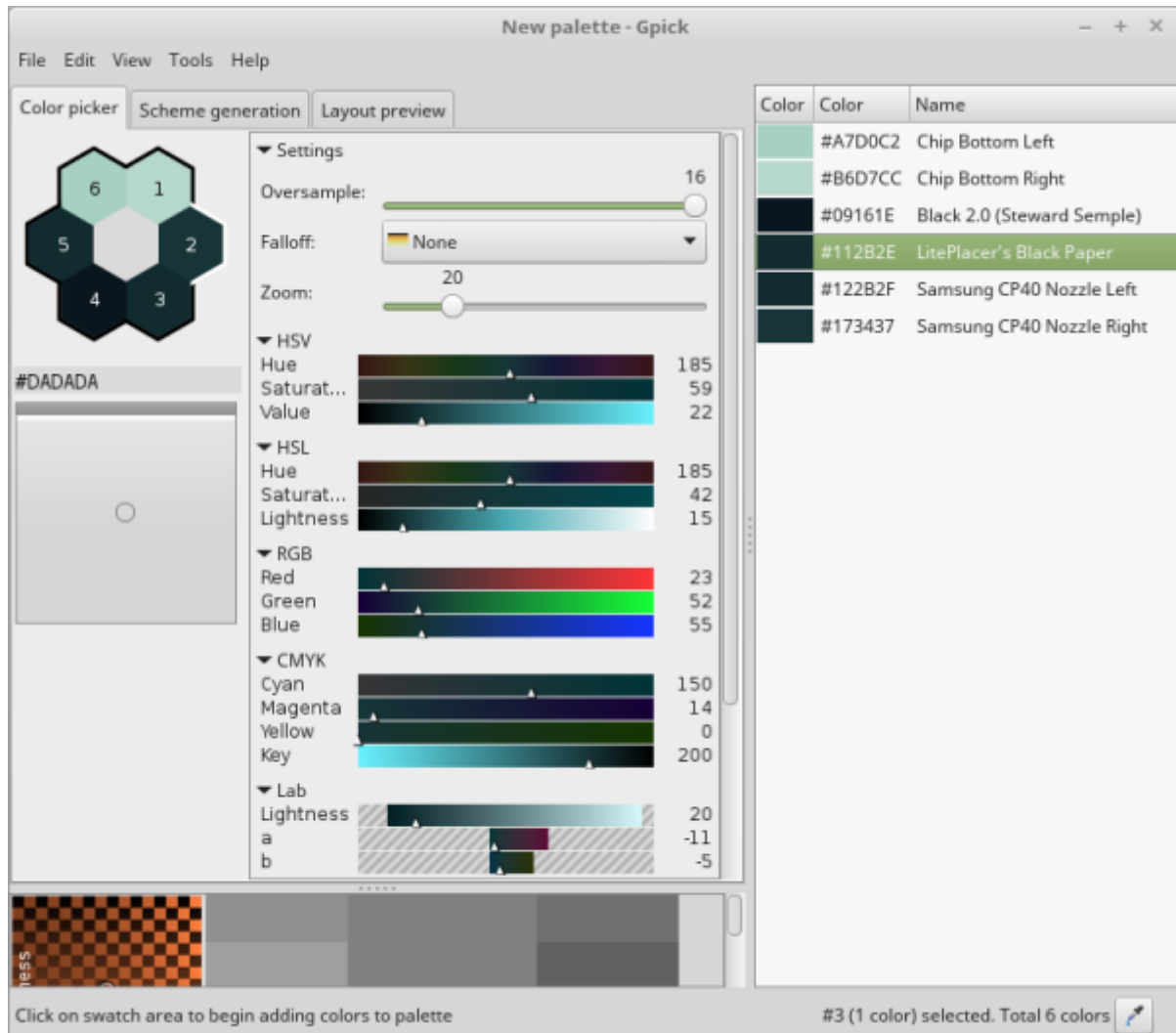
## GPick

Get colours of your screen.

```
sudo apt install gpick
```

## Usage

Click on one of the 6 hexagons from the top left, and then move the cursor to a pixel, you want to get the colour from, and then hit the **space bar**. If the source colour is noisy, you can add **averaging filters** with different weight curves. This is called „oversample“ and „falloff“. On the right side in the list you can **rename** your colours
